Lindsborg Community Hospital and Bethany Village are the building blocks to start your healthcare profession. Nationwide shortages in the nursing field are increasing, but in McPherson County, one local charitable organization is taking steps to help. The founding member of the organization was so impressed with the care and graciousness of certified nursing assistants (CNAs) during a hospital stay, he initiated the sponsorship of local CNA classes. Four summer sessions are available, each session limited. Classes meet during the week, Monday-Friday. Tuition, books, fees, and meals are underwritten 100% with no cost to the student.



Certified Nursing Assistants are responsible for the basic care of patients. They have different duties according to the experience and the type of facility they serve. Duties may include assisting patients who are unable to feed themselves, bathing, grooming, dressing, helping patients to move about, measuring intake and output, measuring and recording vital signs, making beds, observing the patients mental, physical, and emotional condition and reporting to the nursing or medical staff.

When applying to Hutchinson Community College, you must provide the information from the hospital's confirmation letter, which class you will attend.

You are responsible for these HCC Registration requirements when accepted:

- LCH Letter of Approval
- HCC Application
- Completion of on-line portion of class
- Brief reading test

Students need to be at least 16 or a Junior in high school if seeking college credit. The student must secure verification through their school principal before the end of spring semester even if they will have graduated. Verification form must be turned in with application.

Requirements

- Submit application to LCH by March 31, 2026
- Commitment to 14 working days of training
- Come to Sessions prepared (paper, pencil, books, and full attention)
- TB skin test - TB tests will be given at LCH for those needing a test. Positive tests require chest x-rays at students expense.
- Must be 16 or older by the first day of class
- Dress Appropriately
